



# **2023 WASCC Motor Racing Championships – Standing Regulations**



## 1. ADMINISTRATION

- a) The Series shall be officially known as the “WASCC Championships”, hereinafter referred to as “the Championships”.
- b) The Championships consist of multiple categories and classes as per “5. Categories and Classes”
- c) The organisers of the Championship and Series shall be the WA Sporting Car Club, hereinafter referred to as "the Organisers".
- d) The Organisers reserve the right at any time to amend these regulations.

## 2. ELIGIBILITY,

- a) Participants are required to be WASCC members to be eligible for Championship and Series trophies. Should a non-member apply for WASCC membership prior to their 2<sup>nd</sup> event for the season, the points accrued by the new member in their first event will count towards the total points for the Championship. (Membership subject acceptance by the WASCC Committee)
- b) All competitors, whether WASCC members or non-members are eligible for trophies at individual events (rounds).

## 3. Points

- A) All Series events count towards the championships
- B) Championship points will be awarded in line with events points awarded for each event listed in “6. Calendar”

## 4. DETERMINATION OF WINNERS

- A) Each Championship winner will be determined by the highest aggregated total of Championship points in all events listed in “6. Calendar”
- B) In the event of two or more competitors having the same point’s total; the winner shall be the competitor with the highest number of race wins. In the event of two or more competitors having the same number of race wins, the winner shall be the competitor with the highest number of 2<sup>nd</sup> places and so on. If the results remain locked beyond these count backs, a tie will be declared.
- C) Trophies will be awarded for first place in each category or class with 3 or more competitors, 2<sup>nd</sup> place for 6 or more competitors, 3<sup>rd</sup> place for 9 or more competitors as well as any other awards the organiser deems appropriate.
