1. Administration

WA Sporting Car Club (WASCC) Tarmac Sportz Series Events will be held under the:

- FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices.
- National Competition Rules (NCR) of Motorsport Australia.
- Motorsport Australia Hillclimb Standing Regulations.
- WASCC Tarmac Sportz Championship Standing Regulations; and,
- These Supplementary Regulations and any amendments, Further Regulations, Event Bulletins and Instructions to competitors that may be issued.

WASCC Events will be conducted in accordance with the Motorsport Australia OH&S, Motorsport Australia Safety 1st, Integrity and Legal, and Risk Management Policies. These policies are available from the Motorsport Australia website (<u>www.motorsport.org.au</u>) and on the CARCO.com.au Raceway website (<u>www.wascc.com.au</u>). A copy is available for viewing on the Notice Board in the Race Office.

The Event shall be a Car Club Hillclimb Event.

2. Entries

2.1. Entry Lodgment

- a) Entries open on publication of these Supplementary Regulations.
- b) Entry forms are to be lodged via the Motorsport Australia online entry system <u>www.motorsport.org.au</u> (Member Portal) before the closing time and date of 4pm, Wednesday, October 11th
- c) With the submission of their entry, the competitor(s) give their agreement, also on behalf of their driver(s), pit crew and sponsors, that the Organiser may record all activities in connection with the Event and have them transmitted by radio, television, or other media. No claims against the organiser or the transmission company may be raised.
- d) All **non-log booked** entrants are to lodge the following forms, via email, with the Event Manager (<u>evententry@wascc.asn.au</u>) prior to 4pm, Wednesday, October 11th.
- e) Self-Scrutiny Checklist: motorsport-australia self-scrutiny-checklist-speed.pdf
- f) Self-Scrutiny Vehicle Compliance: <u>self_statement-of-vehicle-compliance.pdf (motorsport.org.au)</u>
- g) Ensure forms are correctly completed with all required information. Submission of incomplete or incorrectly filled-out forms may result in non-acceptance of entry.
- h) Should a Competitor or Driver be under 18 years of age, the consent of his/her parent or guardian must appear on the Entry Form.

2.2. Entry Fees

Driver Entry (WASCC Member)	\$120.00
Driver Entry	\$150.00

All Entry Fees **MUST** be received <u>on or prior</u> to the closing date of entries of the event as per the NCR.

All Entry Fees are to be paid <u>directly</u> to the WASCC, via direct deposit. An invoice will be sent via email outlining all payment details.

Any withdrawal made prior to the event closing date will be entitled to a full refund if payment has been made. Those received after the event closing date, yet 24 hours prior to the event starting, will incur a \$50 fee. The balance of monies paid minus this fee will be held in credit.

Any withdrawal received within the final 24-hour period will not be entitled to any credit or refund.

2.3. Acceptance and Oversubscribed Entries

The Organisers will restrict entries to 100 participants. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt. WASCC Members will have priority should the event be over subscribed. Competitors will be given the option to receive conditional acceptance and be placed on a reserve entry list if another competitor withdraws. Competitors who do not accept this option will receive a full refund of the entry fee paid.

2.4. Refusal of Entries

The Organisers reserve the right to refuse entry in accordance with the NCR.

3. General

- Trailers, tow trucks & transporters are not to be parked in the paddock area.
- Golf buggies and WASCC approved modes of transport <u>ONLY</u> (other than your feet) are permitted in the paddock area.
- Automobiles may be loaded prior to the event finish outside of the car park area and not obstructing the movement of any other vehicle.
- Failure to adhere to these safety requirements may see the competitor charged.

4. Document Check

4.1. Competition Licence

All Drivers will have their Motorsport Australia licences checked through the Motorsport Australia electronic platform.

4.2. Driver's Briefing

The drivers briefing will be held at a time and location indicated on the timetable.

5. Scrutineering

5.1. Vehicle Scrutiny

Log booked automobiles will be examined throughout the competition as per the Motorsport Australia Targeted Scrutiny Program. Logbooks are to be dropped in the event bucket on entry to the Driver's Briefing.

At the conclusion of the event, drivers or pit crew must retrieve the logbook.

5.2. Vehicle Eligibility

Each vehicle must comply to the Motorsport Australia Manual Technical Appendix Schedule A & B.

5.3. Apparel

All competitors must wear suitable apparel compliant with Motorsport Australia Technical Appendix Schedule D.

6. Competition Procedures

As per the 2023 WASCC Tarmac Sportz Standing Regulations – 8. Hill Climb

6.1. Trophies

Trophies will be presented outside the Jack's Hill Race Office following the conclusion of the Event.

Trophies will be awarded as follows:

- Hill Climb 1st 2nd 3rd
- "Speed Demon" for the competitor with the fastest outright run time of the event.
- "Time King" for the competitor closest to their nominated run time in any session of the event.

7. Damage to Track

Damage to Track infrastructure may be charged to competitor at the discretion of the Promotor. This includes all facilities within the CARCO.com.au Raceway fence line.

8. Protests

Protests must be lodged in accordance with the NCR.

9. Integrity, Alcohol, Drugs and Other Substances

Motorsport Australia's National Integrity Framework and any associated policy (including the Australian Anti- Doping Policy. Motorsport Australia's Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy and the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy), apply to any activity authorised by Motorsport Australia as published at <u>www.motorsport.org.au</u>.

Any Participant including the holder of a Motorsport Australia License (or a License issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol, any drug or other banned substance. In addition to any penalty imposed by Motorsport Australia, a further penalty/s may be applied by Sport Integrity Australia. Consumption of alcohol in any Reserved Area (as defined in the NCR) is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day.

10. Postponement, Abandonment and Cancellations of Competition

The Organiser reserves the right to abandon, postpone or stop the Event in accordance with the NCR.

11. Smoking

CARCO.com.au Raceway has strict 'no-smoking' areas in accordance with WA statutes and designated areas including the Paddock and pit areas.
