## 5.3 Starting Procedures

d) Free Formula: All races to commence from a rolling start as per CRSR 5.5 with an initial out lap from dummy grid passing by the start finish line once before commencing their start.

## 5.5 Event Lengths

- ~~a) Unless stated elsewhere in these regulations or further regulations, race lengths for ALL categories will be:
  - i. Race 1 and 3: 8 laps
  - ii. Race 2: 10 Laps~~
- ~~b) Formula Vee
  - i. Race 1, 3 and 4: 8 laps
  - ii. Race 2 and 5: 10 laps~~

Race lengths for each category will be as follows with the time commencing at the time the Start Signal is given:

- a) Formula Vee
  - i. Races 1, 3, 4 and 5: 8 laps or 11 minutes + 1 lap
  - ii. Race 2: 10 laps or 13 minutes + 1 lap
- b) HQ Holdens
  - i. Races 1 and 3: 8 laps or 12 minutes + 1 lap
  - ii. Race 2: 10 laps or 15 minutes + 1 lap
- c) Improved Production/3E Production/Street Cars
  - i. Races 1 and 3: 8 laps or 11 minutes + 1 lap
  - ii. Race 2: 10 laps or 13 minutes + 1 lap
- d) Saloon Cars
  - i. Races 1 and 3: 8 laps or 11 minutes + 1 lap
  - ii. Race 2: 10 laps or 14 minutes + 1 lap
- e) Sports Sedans/Sports Cars/WA Muscle Cars
  - i. Races 1 and 2: 15 laps or 17 minutes + 1 lap
- f) Formula Ford:

i. Races 1 and 3: 8 laps or 11 minutes + 1 lap

ii. Race 2: 10 laps or 13 minutes + 1 lap

g) FSR:

i. Races 1 and 3: 8 laps or 10 minutes + 1 lap

ii. Race 2: 10 laps or 12 minutes + 1 lap

h) Historic Touring Cars:

i. Races 1 and 3: 8 laps or 12 minutes + 1 lap

ii. Race 2: 10 laps or 14 minutes + 1 lap

i) Free Formula:

i. Races 1 and 3: 8 laps or 10 minutes + 1 lap

ii. Race 2: 10 laps or 13 minutes + 1 lap

### 7.3 Qualifying

a) Qualifying will be in 4 x 20 minute sessions 2 x 20 minute sessions

~~b) Clause S8.2 of the 2023 Circuit Excel Nationals Sporting Regulations outlines the cars permitted to compete in each of the qualifying sessions:~~

~~I. Qualifying 1 – Odd numbered Automobiles~~

~~II. Qualifying 2 – Even numbered Automobiles~~

~~III. Qualifying 3 – Fastest 50% from combined Q1 & Q2 results~~

~~IV. Qualifying 4 – Slowest 50% from combined Q1 & Q2 results~~

b) All competitors will be permitted to compete in all qualifying sessions.

### 7.4 Grid Determination

~~As per Clause S9 of the 2023 Circuit Excel Nationals Sporting Regulations:~~

Heat 1 – Fastest Qualifier to Pole

Heat 2 – From finishing result of Heat 1

Heat 3 - Will be determined from the points awarded in Heat 1 and Heat 2 with highest points scorer to pole

Race 1 – Will be determined from the points awarded in Heats 1 to 3 with highest points scorer to pole

Race 2 - Will be determined from the points awarded in Heats 1 to 3 and Race 1 with highest points scorer to pole

### 7.5 Event Lengths

i. ~~Heats 1 to 6~~ Heats 1 to 3: 10 Laps or 14 minutes + 1 lap

ii. Race 1 (Repechage): 15 Laps or 20 minutes + 1 lap

iii. Race 2 (Final): 20 Laps or 26 minutes + 1 lap
